The Season After Pentecost, also called Ordinary Time or Kingdomtide, is a period which may include as few as 23 or as many as 28 Sundays. The season begins with Trinity Sunday (the first Sunday after Pentecost) and continues through the day before the First Sunday of Advent. The Sundays of this season are designated as Sundays after Pentecost.
