Belinda Gaskins: Fund raising for expenses and air fare for mission trip to Sudan. Dorothy Scott presented information about Carolina Christian Book Fairs. Discussed and approved book fair. This needs to be presented to Outreach Committee. Contact Dave Munro for use of Celebration Center. Contact Larry Bevins or Paul Evans for use of Sunday School rooms.

Marsha Six: New bus lettering was presented and chosen by trustees.

The loan for the bus will be paid off by cashing a CD for \$26,500. A check in the amount of \$15,900 will be given to Dave and Barbara Amaker to pay off the loan in full. Encourage members to keep donating for upkeep of new bus. Repairs were needed for the bus on a recent youth trip.

The balance of the CD will be used for updating cupboards and replacing floor and stove in the parsonage kitchen. A contract with Kennedy Renovations has been signed and work will be scheduled after March 1<sup>st</sup>. Johnise Nuttycombe has given us a bid of \$1,000 to remove wallpaper, repair drywall as needed, and paint the parsonage kitchen. The bid was accepted by trustees.

Colonial Ext. were called when mouse droppings were found in the old kitchen. A thorough extermination process was given to particular areas of the church

Dave Munro: LINK accepted the donation of the old bus and picked it up 2/19/09.

Warren Baker from the City of N. N. Dept. of Social Services has requested use of the CC for a volunteer recognition reception on April 1 from 3 to 5 p.m. He wants the room for free. After discussion, it was decided that our regular fee for renting the CC will be not be waived for this reception.

Jim Corliss is working on warranty issues concerning the CC floor. We have two "bubbles" and the manufacturer is working on the repair.

She reported she has Grounds Committee volunteers for 2009.

Scott Thompson: will speak to Adam Cooke about taking on more responsibility of the grounds for this year.

The Boy Scout troop has ordered a trailer with lettering on it. This was not cleared with the trustees. When the trailer does arrive, we need a place for it to be stored . An Eagle Scout from our church needs a project. Suggestion that maybe he could build a carport for the trailer. The Long Range Facility Planning Committee will need to know about eventual placement of trailer storage on back of property.

Pastor Steve reported during scout meetings, scout siblings are running through the building unsupervised. He will write a letter to scout leader and make him aware of the problem.
