We began with an examination of the Terry Schiavo case and a study of Jesus’ and Paul’s use of the terms “life” and “death.” The study will include clips from popular movies dealing with death and dying, and a panel of our own medical people discussing issues of life and death. Our four-week course will conclude by dealing with the very important question: if two Christians disagree, is one (or both) wrong? The answer might surprise you. Plan now on joining this significant discussion.
