The general church wants us all to be aware of the fact that Congress is now considering the final plan for the next budget. The suggested plan calls for large reductions in Medicare, Medicaid, food stamps, temporary aid to needy families, and other help for vulnerable people. The General Board of Church and Society of the UM Church challenges the wisdom and humanity of these cuts.

Also, the Violence Against Women Act is under consideration. This act, a product of bi-partisan cooperation, guarantees assistance to women who are victims of rape or other abuse. The church supports this assistance program as it opposes the use of force and violence and seeks to protect women. Let your opinion be known.
