- ◆ Ribbon (gold and red)
- ◆ Ribbon (colors of the rainbow)
- ◆ 2 rolls of wax paper
- ◆ Heavy duty cardboard or scraps from mat boards
- ◆ Dried beans such as navy, pinto or black beans
- ◆ Old buttons, beads or do-dads to use for decorating our crafts
- ◆ Bucket of foam shapes (small size shapes please)
- ◆ Tongue depressors
- ◆ Children/infant size shoe boxes (one is needed for each child attending)*
