Charge Conference

To meet required IRS regulations, we must have a Charge Conference on 2 July 2006 in order to set Pastor Richard's salary, to state the amount Pastor Richard wants out of his salary as accountable reimbursement, to affirm the amount allowed for housing and for heat. These amounts have been approved by the appropriate committees and by our Church Council, but the IRS requires that we conduct the Charge Conference.
