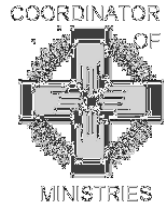

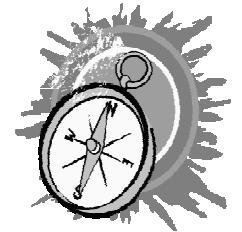
Farm Fresh Receipts
