### Local Missions Project

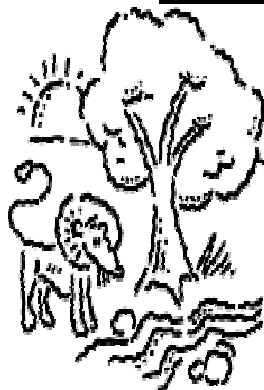
