From the Finance Committee Chair

For those of you who missed the Finance Committee announcement in church last Sunday, here is the impact if we do not raise more income for 2010.

We will not be able to initiate the new worship service that we desperately need and desire because we cannot fund the Contemporary Music Director position, necessary start-up and operational expenses, and a fee for an advisor/consultant that our pastors believe is essential to ensure a high probability of success for this service. The Minister of Pastoral Care position cannot be funded. Other items in the Staff-Parish budget to include staff training will be eliminated or reduced. We will be unable to put money into our rainy day funds for major church repairs, parsonage repair, and rental property repair. The Trustees budget has been reduced to bare bones operations and will require additional money if we experience higher than normal heating/air conditioning expenses or we face more than normal maintenance costs. All program ministries and support to missions will be reduced by 10%. In order to keep cuts even at this level, we will have to reduce our prudent reserve from \$50,000 to \$20,000.

I'll report back to you next weekend after the Finance Committee meets this afternoon with the Committee Chairs and after Council approves our actions on January 21st.
