The United Methodist Men will be having dinner and a meeting on **February 9 at 6:30 p.m.** We encourage all men of Warwick Memorial to come and join us.

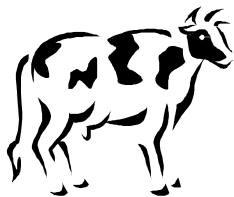
