There were several requests for the chicken salad recipe served at the luncheon on May 2. If you are interested, you may pick up a copy in the church office. Billie Quigley

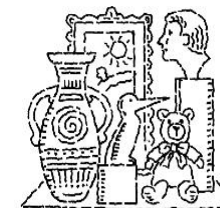


Calling all Retirees and Volunteers
