Celebration Center Debt Reduction!

Because of the faithfulness, generosity, and commitment of the wonderful WMUMC congregation during our Destination Freedom Campaign, we will soon be reducing our Celebration Center debt to slightly below \$2 million. Hallelujah! At its regular July 15, 2010, meeting, the Church Council approved a recommendation by the Building Fund Finance Committee to pay an additional \$90,000 toward the reduction of the principal balance in conjunction with the regular August 9th, 2010, mortgage payment. This extra payment is possible because of the generous response of over \$114,000 to the First Fruits offering. This reduction of principal will save about \$135,000 in future interest costs and, under the terms of the current lending agreement, shorten our loan term by 15 months. Words simply are not sufficient for the thankfulness your leadership team feels toward such a wonderful congregation. Praise the Lord!
