

the stained glass windows at the front of the church and along both sides of the Sanctuary were gifted and installed in1981 and 1982. The large window, entitled "The Holy Trinity," window, was given by Dr. Forest McCoig in memory of his wife, Katherine.

Symbols of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are shown with the Hand of God, the Descending Dove (Holy Spirit), and the Chi Rho (representing the Son). The Cross and Flame on the left side represents the United Methodist Church. The 17 smaller memorial and honorary side windows illustrating Christ's life, Biblical events, and traditional Christian symbols, were given by families of Warwick Memorial.

Drawings of the designs can be found in a notebook our library, which has drawings of each window with the explanation of the artwork and Biblical references.
